- **Early Bird Registration Deadline and Entry Fee: September 20, \$125**
- **Final Registration and Entry Fee: October 4, 2019, \$160**
- **Manadatory Parade Participants Meeting: Wednesday, October 9th, from 6:30-7:30PM at Sentara CarePlex (3000 Coliseum Drive) in Conference Rooms B&C**
- **Parade Details:** The parade begins on Saturday, November 23, 2019 at 9:30AM. Units must be at Hampton Roads Center Parkway and Coliseum Drive no later than 7AM

All units must adhere to the following criteria:

- **Holiday Theme: "Celebrate the Season!"** All units must have decorations in keeping with the holiday theme. Decorations must be described in detail on your application. Units cannot display or handout any political preferences and materials. This will be checked during parade lineup and if unit has misrepresented itself it will be disqualified.
- **Pre-Parade Meeting:** Each unit scheduled to participate in the 2019 holiday parade must send a representative to a mandatory pre-parade meeting. Please note that this meeting is **mandatory**, failure to attend could result in your unit being disqualified. The meeting will occur on **Wednesday, October 9th, from 6:30-7:30PM located at Sentara CarePlex (3000 Coliseum Drive) in Conference Rooms B&C.** Unit positions will be announced.
- **Transportation to Hampton Roads Center Parkway:** Make plans early with your group regarding meeting location and vehicle parking. Shuttles to the staging area will be available beginning at 7AM from Riverpointe Shopping Center. **Please note that animals are not allowed on the shuttle buses and cannot be parked on Hampton Roads Center Parkway.**
- **Official Walker:** Each entry must provide an "official walker" to march in front of your entry carrying the official parade unit number. The official walker is necessary for correct identification for commentary, safety, and judging.
- **Forward-Marching:** The parade will be forward marching for everyone. Each unit's performances along the parade route and at the reviewing stand must be performed in a forward march manner. Parade Marshals will be stationed along the parade route to enforce forward movement of parade at all times.
- **Identification:** All units including non-commercial organizations must be identified. In the case of floats or motorized units name identification must be on both sides. Bands, marching and animal units must provide name identification in front of your unit. All celebrities or officials must be identified on both sides of motor vehicles or floats in the general location of

the person.

- **Distribution of Materials:** Flowers, samples, candy, literature or other materials of any sort shall not be thrown. Units must have walkers beside their unit to distribute items.
- **Santa Claus:** The "Real" Santa Claus will appear in the parade; No Santa Claus costumes are permitted in your unit.
- **Competition:** Competing units are judged by the National Judging Association. Failure to submit a W9 will disqualify the unit from competition.

Types of Entries:

- **Animal:** An entry that includes animals. Type and number of animals must be indicated on application. Animals must wear holiday decorations and be under handler's control at all times. Use of live animals on floats must have Committee approval. Each unit is responsible for cleaning up after their own animals.
- **Band: (High School Band or Other)** A group that marches while playing musical instruments. The number of participants is not limited but everyone marching should be in uniform.
- **Float: (Commercial or Non-Commercial)** A decorated and lighted/or not lighted structure that is self-propelled or pulled by a motor vehicle. All visible sides must be completely covered with decorations. Floats must be constructed and decorated so that each side is equally attractive and interesting.
- **Maximum Dimensions:** 10' wide x 13' high. Walkers accompanying floats are limited to 10 persons. Those marching must be 10 years of age or older due to the route length (approximately 1.7 miles).
- **Motorized:** Motor vehicles. All vehicles must be decorated and may be illuminated if desired. Motor vehicle units will be allowed a maximum of four vehicles per club/organization.
- **Other:** Includes an individual or group other than a band, float, or motor vehicle that marches the parade route in costume or uniform.
